Roll Sessions Policies

- All boats must be clean. Remove air bags and wash the boat, inside and out. Do this at home. Dirty boats are not allowed in the pool.
- To avoid damage to the pool, deck, and tiled surfaces, remove metal rudders from sea kayaks. No aluminum canoes permitted. Do not launch off the deck of the pool—enter your boat while it is sitting in the water.
- No free swimming or diving permitted.
- Helmets are required, whether you are in a boat or standing in the water helping someone.
