Meeting

The meeting was called to order by D Clark at 7:03 pm at the Lakewood Board of Education. A motion to approve the minutes of the January 23, 2017, meeting was heard by Kevin Fischer, seconded by Cliff Burkhardt. The motion carried.

Communications/Old Business

Vacant Commission Position - A open seat on the Adult Athletic Commission remains vacant.

Community Outreach - R. Wallenhorst reported that he continues to promote the June 3, 2017, Kickball tournament via outreach to local bars, ads in The Observer, and Facebook posts. Emails will be sent again to current kickball and flag football team managers.

Registration is \$50/team; 16 teams would be a full field.

R. Wallenhorst reported the City has not yet published a date for the Friday Night Flicks in August, which determine the date of the City Challenge games.

M. Wetzler reported that the Lakewood Women's Club voted not to hold the Great Pumpkin Fun Run & 5K in 2017, and encouraged the Commission to seek out other community events to support.

Review of Sports

Basketball - R. Wallenhorst reported that the Men's 6' & Under league will wrap up their season by mid-March; the other two Men's leagues will continue into April The Women's League has four teams, and began play on February 26, 2017.

Volleyball - Three registrations were received for the open gym offering, not enough to proceed with the program.

Flag Football - No report.

Softball - Registration opened February 1, 2017. Registrations for the Men's Wednesday night

league (doubleheader league) are full at 14 teams. Soft registrations in the Tuesday/Thursday AA and A leagues prompted R. Wallenhorst to change the format to a Tuesday night doubleheader high league; 10 teams have since registered. Registration in the remaining Men's (Sunday High and Low0 and CoEd (Monday doubleheader, Tuesday/Thursday, and Sunday) leagues are slower.

Five teams are expected to register for the Men's Senior league, and individual registrations for the Women's Senior league are trickling in. Another ad will be placed in The Observer to promote the Women's Senior league.

Kickball – Registration opens April 14, 2017.

New Business

Following A. Gold's trip to Florida, conversation regarding offering Pickleball was reignited. T. Bratz lobbied again to introduced Hoover Ball.

M. Wetzler suggested the AAC field a team for the Kickball tournament.

T. Bratz moved to adjourn at 7:53 pm; Kevin Fischer seconded the motion. The motion carried. The next scheduled meeting of the ACC will be on March 27, 2017, at 7 p.m., at the Board of Education .
