Meeting

The meeting was called to order by Derek Clark at 7:05 pm at the Lakewood Board of Education. A motion to approve the minutes of the February 27, 2017, meeting was heard by Art Gold, seconded by Cliff Burkhart. The motion carried.

Communications/Old Business

Vacant Commission Position - An application for the open seat on the Adult Athletic Commission has been received, and will be acted on by the CREC Board.

Community Outreach - R. Wallenhorst reported that he continues to promote the June 3, 2017, Kickball tournament via an article in The Observer, Facebook posts, and emails to current kickball and flag football team managers; no registrations have been received yet.

Registration is \$50/team; 16 teams would be a full field.

R. Wallenhorst reported the City has not yet published a date for the Friday Night Flicks in August, which determine the date of the City Challenge games.

No action has been taken with regard to new offerings for Pickleball or Hooverball.

Members of the ACC agreed to field a team for the Kickball tournament.

Review of Sports

Basketball - R. Wallenhorst reported that the Men's 6' & Under league wrapped up their season on March 22; the other two Men's leagues have concluded regular season play, and begin playoffs on March 28. The Women's League has been going well.

Volleyball - Will offer again in the Fall as a Sunday night open gym format.

Softball – Registration opened February 1, 2017, and 77 teams have registered as of March 27. In 2016, a total of 96 teams participated in leagues, and R. Wallenhorst believes we will again reach that number.

Registrations for the Men's Wednesday night league (doubleheader league), Men's High Tuesday night league (doubleheader league) and Co-Ed Tuesday/Thursday night league are all full. Registration in the remaining Men's (Sunday High and Low) and Co-Ed (Monday doubleheader and Sunday) leagues are filling in.

Five teams are expected to register for the Men's Senior league. Eight individual registrations for the Women's Senior league have been received, registration for that league is open through mid-April.

Kickball – Registration opens April 14, 2017.

New Business

T. Bratz questioned whether CREC had advised of a budget for the ACC. No information on that has been received by either D. Clark or R. Wallenhorst.

T. Bratz moved to adjourn at 7:30 pm; C. Burkhardt seconded the motion. The motion carried. The next scheduled meeting of the ACC will be on April 24, 2017, at 7 p.m., at the Board of Education.
