Meeting

The meeting was called to order by Derek Clark at 7:05 pm at the Lakewood Board of Education. A motion to approve the minutes of the March 27, 2017, meeting was heard by Cliff Burkhart, seconded by Troy Bratz. The motion carried.

Communications/Old Business

Vacant Commission Position - no update.

Community Outreach - R. Wallenhorst reported that he continues to promote the June 3, 2017, Kickball tournament. No registrations have been received yet, but three teams have expressed interest. Members of the ACC agreed to field a team for the Kickball tournament.

Point of Information - A. Gold informed the Committee that the City has signed a bid to transform the tennis courts at Merl & Bunts into mixed-use courts to accommodate pickle ball.

Review of Sports

Basketball - R. Wallenhorst reported that all of the Men's leagues wrapped up their seasons. The Women's League has been going well, and will conclude play on April 30, 2017; two teams not currently in the league have expressed interest in playing next year.

Volleyball - Will offer again in the Fall as a Sunday night open gym format.

Flag Football – No report.

Softball – Registration has closed, and 100 teams have registered. In 2016, a total of 96 teams participated in leagues; and 89 teams participated in 2015. Play begins on April 30, 2017.

Registrations for the existing leagues was solid; the Men's Sunday High and Low leagues for both day and evening were combined. Not enough individual registrations for the Women's Senior league have been received to create a league.

Kickball – Registration is currently open, and will close on May 15, 2017. Nine teams have registered: 7 for Thursday Low; 1 for Thursday High; and 1 for Friday. R. Wallenhorst expects the leagues to be at capacity.

New Business

No new business was brought before the Commission.

C. Burkhart moved to adjourn at 7:18 pm; A. Gold seconded the motion. The motion carried. The next scheduled meeting of the ACC will be on May 22, 2017, at 7 p.m., at the Board of Education.
