**Meeting**

**Communications/Old Business**

Community Outreach - Rick Wallenhorst reported that the City Challenge games, scheduled for August 11, 2017, at Madison Park, were canceled due to weather/field conditions.

New Sports - R. Wallenhorst informed the Commission that pickup games of futsal are happening at the new courts.

There has not yet been a follow-up met with a representative of the Broomball league. This led to discussion around the possible closing of Winterhurst as an ice rink, and other options for the facility as related to sports.

**Review of Sports**

Basketball - Registration for 2017-18 season for all leagues opens October 1, 2017. Mens' leagues begin play in December, the Women's league will begin in January, 2018.

Volleyball - No registrations were received for the Sunday open gym format.

Flag Football - Registration will opened July 1, 2017, for the Fall season. Eight teams have registered so far (6 registered in 2016), and the season will begin on September 6, 2017.

Softball - All summer leagues have wrapped up, and registration is open for the Fall season,

which begins the week of September 6, 2017. The Senior League will wrap up on September 22, 2017.
