**Meeting**

Cliff Burkhart called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m. at the Lakewood Board of Education. Minutes of the February 25, 2019, meeting were moved for approval by C Burkhart, and seconded by Derek Clark. Motion carried.

**Communications/Old Business**

Rick Wallenhorst reported that an article ran in the early March edition of the Lakewood Observer promoting spring/summer adult sports.

**Review of Sports**

Basketball - The championship game in the Men's 6' & Under league will be played on March 25. Play continues for all leagues (Men's B and Women's); playoffs will begin in April.

Flag Football – Registration for the summer league has opened. One team has registered, and at least four more have expressed interest. The league will play on Saturday mornings at Garfield Middle School, with games beginning on May 25, 2019.

Softball – Registration for Spring leagues opened on January 1, 2019. 81 teams have registered as of March 25, and R Wallenhorst expects at least six more, plus the Senior League (4 teams). Due to lack of interest, the Sunday morning Women's league will not form. A managers meeting will be held on April 18, and games will begin on April 28, 2019; the Senior League will begin mid-May.

Kickball – Registration for Spring leagues opens on April 1, 2019.
