- I. Meeting called to order at 6:34. Roll call taken. Motion to excuse Commissioner Stolitza was presented by Commissioner Fraunfelder with a second provided by Commissioner Gold. Vote taken and the motion passed 6-0.
- II. **Approval of minutes:** A motion to approve the minutes from the January 29, 2018 meeting was made by Commissioner Gold with a second provided by Commissioner Schroeck. Vote taken and the minutes were approved as presented 6-0.
- III. **Communications/Public Comments:** None
- IV. **Coordinator's Report:** A copy of the draft minutes from the January 29, 2018 meeting plus a copy of the Lakewood Community Education and Recreation (CREC) Financial presentation and the feedback from the 2018 Joint Commission retreat were emailed to each CREC member prior to the meeting. At the meeting an article was provided "Kid Sports" published in Time magazine 9/17. Coordinator Krogman review the account structure of the financial presentation.
