- I. Call to Order Roll Call 6:40
  - a. Excused Andy Comer (Mabry/Shachner 4-0)
- II. Minutes May and June
  - a. Move to approve (Showalter/Cheryl 4-0)
- III. New business
  - a. Sean Jones resignation acceptance (Showalter/Cheryl 4-0)
  - b. Matt Markling resignation acceptance (Shachner/Cheryl 4-0)

  - e. Program Growth/Evaluation
    - i. Mr. Wallenhorst provided a chart of program registration numbers for all sports.
    - ii. Mr. Wallenhorst noted that soccer registrations have increased considerably and that the volleyball camp already has 11 registrations after being open for only a week.
    - iii. Cross county registration will be open for another week and cheerleading has 16 registrations.
    - iv. 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> grade tackle did not reach the minimum registrations needed to field a league.
      1. Mr. Wallenhorst emailed the parents and moved all registrants over to flag football.

    - vi. Camps

1. Ms. Krogman shared that there was no girls' basketball camp this year, but some of the girl did participate in the boys' camp. The volleyball camp was successful. Ms. Favre noted that the driving force behind the success of the camps is coordination with the varsity coaches. Ms. Favre shared that her staff is working hard to reach out to these coaches. Ms. Wereb reiterated that she understood that the reason that there was no girls' basketball camps was because of the coach's limited availability.

f. Communications/PR

- i. Mr. Fraunfelder stated that the previously discussed PR initiative at the last CREC meeting. Ms. Mabry asked if anything was submitted in writing and Mr. Fraunfelder responded in the negative. Mr. Fraunfelder was hopeful that the PR initiative will be moving forward because Mr. Markling will be joining CREC. Mr. Fraunfelder said that CREC will be pulling from other commissions for the task force. Mr. Showalter feels that there are missed opportunities on the Facebook page. He saw only one championship game picture and wants to see more engagement and more pictures. If there are more pictures then parents will comment and engage with the page.

IV. Old Business

a. Purchase pass

- i. Ms. Krogman was unable to get all the necessary parties together yet. Mr. Fraunfelder is adding the pass item to the CREC agenda. He was to investigate what the different revenue streams are.

V. Other Business

a. White pants no white pants

- i. Mr. Showalter brought up that there appears to be inconsistent enforcement of the white pants rule in the baseball league. Mr. Showalter could not find anywhere in the rules that stated that white pants are required. Mr. Wallenhorst and Ms. Krogman were surprised by that. Ms. Krogman believed that the rule may have been deleted by accident in a revision, but that has been the rule for years. Mr. Showalter acknowledge that it has been the rule for years and also said that it might be time to review the rules and see if they need updating.

b. Random Draw

- i. Mr. Showalter expressed a dislike for the random draw tournament seeding. Ms. Krogman shared that the rule originated around 3 years ago because some 10U teams were getting slaughtered and the decision was made that if tournament seeding was random then the focus can be on learning the game rather than winning. All parties

agreed that this can be looked at again and that a rules revision may be in order.
