Program Growth / Evaluation

- a. Mr. Wallenhorst provided the current fall registration numbers. There has been an increase from August to September. The registration numbers are fairly consistent with the 2017 season with the exception of travel soccer is down by 46 participants.

Mr. Nelson asked how much travel soccer costs (roughly \$175) and how many games they play in a season. Mr. Wallenhorst didn't have the details about the number of games but said Mrs. Favre Krogman would know.

Volleyball has been moved to a winter sport instead of fall.

Mr. Wallenhorst reported that Basketball and winter cheerleading registration opened on September 1st.

- b. Mr. Wallenhorst stated that travel football began last weekend but he was unable to attend any games. Mr. Comer explained that the 3rd/4th grade modified flag game was a good game and the 5th/6th grade team did not play, but have had a lot of scrimmages. Mr. Comer reported that the league seems

to be off to a good start but there have been some bumps as it is the first time for this program.

Mr. Wallenhorst explained that the scheduling of the league was a challenge. Increasing from 22 teams to 47 teams made it hard to find fields and officials for all the games.

- c. Mr. Wallenhorst reported that the in house football league might have to combine with other cities next year in order to give the teams more variety in who they play. Mr. Comer asked if we could get a breakdown of boys per grade level in the school district. Mr. Wallenhorst will get that information for the commission.
