DIVISIONS

Pee Wee Basketball League (COED grades 1 - 2)

Resident \$55/NR \$75

Players participate in 4 x 4 basketball games using an 8' basket, youth sized basketball, on side or shorter basketball courts. Games are played at Harrison Elementary School. There are 3 group practices that are to be determined:

LHS Head Coach Alex Cammock, staff, and players oversee the group practices and games. Coaches are responsible to schedule individual practices after the conclusion of group practices.

3rd/4th Boys and Girls Basketball Leagues

Players participant in a 5 x 5 league using 10' basket, 28.5 intermediate sized basketball on full courts. Games sites are to be determined. The season consists of 10 regular season games followed by a 1-day single elimination tournament.

5th/6th Boys Basketball League
